Carroll County Sheriff's Matron Completes Training; Jail Commander Receives Certification

Carroll County Sheriff's Matron Aleisha Williamson and Jail Commander Lori Sustarsic recently completed training and certification in two unrelated programs.

Matron Williamson participated in a two day training seminar involving social media. The program was hosted by the Lafayette Police Department and was offered through Bartlett, Illinois based company, G.A.T.E. America. G.A.T.E. is the acronym for Gang Awareness Training Education. The company offers extensive training in many law enforcement realms. Matron Williamson received training which will assist the Sheriff's office in their use of Facebook and other social media.
